

Talli Nauman is co-founder of the international media project Journalism to Raise Environmental Awareness, initiated with a MacArthur grant in 1994. She is the Contributing Editor at Buffalo's Fire-Indigenous Media Freedom Alliance. She is the Editor of her own publication Meloncoyote, a bilingual newsletter teaming prize-winning environmental journalists and aspiring youth in training sessions to advance media coverage of sustainability issues in Northwest Mexico and Southwest U.S.A. She served as Society of Environmental Journalists Diversity Associate, co-authoring the organization's Guide to Diversity in Environmental Reporting. She wrote the first guide to Environmental Journalism in Latin America, originally published in 2018. Her experience encompasses 45 years in major media outlets in the Americas, including The Guardian, Reuters, Los Angeles Times Syndicate, UPI, and AP in Los Angeles and Mexico City. She has an MA in International Journalism from University of Southern California and a BA in Visual and Environmental Studies from Harvard-Radcliffe.
